DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

What would we do if faced with the threat of losing everything? Our house, our success, our job, our family? What if we had to face the possibility of being left totally alone? How far would we go to have it all? A good job, social success, a beautiful house, a happy family?

That is the thread that drives this film, the transitions, the day-to-day decisions people make when thinking only about their own benefit without considering or caring that their actions may be detrimental to others.

"RETRIBUTION" tells the story of Carlos, a bank manager who is excellent at his job, among the best. Thanks to his decisions and tenacity, the bank made lots of money and his prestige is on the rise. His decisions made a few people rich but were harmful to many others. But in life, some people gain and others lose; some are deceitful and others trusting. In the end, it is "each man for himself" in a world where all manner of things happen and are soon forgotten.

"RETRIBUTION" is about an act of revenge in which the executioner is the victim and vice-versa.

On a seemingly normal day, while taking his children to school Carlos receives a phone call from a stranger that will change everything. The man tells Carlos there is a bomb under the seats of his car and that he will detonate it unless Carlos gives him a large amount of money.

"RETRIBUTION" is a disturbing, frenetic thriller that does not give the viewer a moment of peace; there are no concessions, no time to waste. It provokes a rollercoaster of mixed feelings, hasty decisions, and emotions in which every second that elapses is of crucial importance. The story will captivate viewers and put them in the car with Carlos and his children where all that matters is to survive.

In **"RETRIBUTION"** we have created a fascinating *road movie*; a car ride around a city wherein a man has managed to achieve all his personal and professional goals but now the tide has turned against him, threatening to destroy him and his children's lives.

The sea, the wind, the rain, the sun, are part of the vital pulse of a city that awakens one morning and provides a venue for the car ride in which our leading characters play their last cards. The city itself helps build a solid yet unique atmosphere for a story that I hope leaves no one feeling indifferent. It is my wish for the viewer to be in the car and to never forget the experience.

Dani de la Torre (Monforte de Lemos, 1975) is a Spanish director and screenwriter. He studied Image and Sound in Ourense, graduating in the early nineties. Since 1996, he works in Television de Galicia, a public regional broadcasting company where he is a promo producer. Before that he has also directed tv programs in the areas of sports and culture. He combines this work with the direction of short films, commercials and videoclips. His succesful career as a short film director led him to direct the tv miniseries "Mar libre", which achieved the support of both critics and audiences, being awarded in festivals such prestigious as Houston or Chicago. Also he has written and directed the 2013's Mestre Mateo awards gala of the Audiovisual Academy of Galicia. "Retribution" represents his debut in feature films.
